Works completed or continuing on site during July 2018

- Zone 3A roof works completed.
- Lower ground and ground floor slabs poured.
- Cladding to Exeter Street ongoing.
- Zone 4 steel works commenced.
- Zone 7 steel works ongoing, due for completion end of August 2018.
- Loading bay installed.

Planned work in August 2018

- Concrete pours to plant deck and sky bar.
- Cladding commenced to Bretonside.
- Drylining to commence mid August.
- Plumbing and electrical to commence mid August in car park areas.
- Block work to commence late August.
- All steel work to be completed by the end of August.

Work Experience Placements

We have recently hosted six work experience placements on site for 15 year old pupils from Lipson Co-op Academy, Stoke Damerel Community College, Marine Academy Plymouth and Penair School, Cornwall. Four of the placements were arranged via STEM on a new initiative called Generation STEM. Generation STEM is a new programme of work experience related to Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM) for young people aged 14-15 delivered by employers in co-operation with the CSW Enterprise Team. The programme is accredited by Industrial Cadets, an industry-led scheme endorsed by employers such as British Steel and GlaxoSmithKline. We offered a structured, week long work experience placement that included standard elements of the workplace such as a workplace tour, health and safety briefing and self-reflection activities. They also spent time with our site based quantity surveyor, senior engineer, document controller, design manager and site managers.
